The Annual Lord's Acre event brings the community together, allowing us to make connections and build relationships. The Lord's Acre is a tradition that dates back to the earliest day of the Methodist movement in the United States. Parishioners set aside an acre of their best land, dedicating all the produce from that acre to God. We continue that tradition at Brock United Methodist each year on the last Saturday in September. Our Lord's Acre has evolved into a traditional harvest festival with vendor booths, live and silent auctions, children's activities, and a home cooked turkey and dressing dinner. The proceeds of the event go to support the ministries and mission of our congregation, and serve as a major source of funding for the upkeep and maintenance of our facilities.
