


COVID-19 Screening Form

For your safety and the safety of our Church Family, please answer the following questions before participating in our in-person worship services:

- Have you been in close contact with anyone who is laboratory confirmed or has a suspected case of Coronavirus in the past 14 days?
- Have you or anyone close to you traveled outside the DFW and surrounding areas or outside the State of Texas or United States within the last 14 days?
- Are you in a high risk category?
 - You are 65+ years of age
 - You have underlying medical conditions: chronic lung disease, mild to severe asthma, serious heart conditions, immunocompromised, severe obesity, diabetes, chronic kidney disease, liver disease.
- Have you had any of the following symptoms:
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting

Worship Covenant

We covenant to set as our guiding principle the first General Rule of our Methodist Church, as outlined by John Wesley over two hundred years ago in his work with the early United Societies:

Do No Harm.

Because we value the health and wellbeing of all God's people, especially our most vulnerable, we covenant to proceed at a careful pace. We further covenant with one another to do as much as possible to protect those who will share our sacred space with us as we assemble.

To that end, I/we covenant to:

- Screen ourselves prior to attending all church functions. (worship services and small group gatherings)
- Wear face masks while attending indoor church functions with these guidelines:
 - 0-2 years of age no mask
 - 3-9 years of age masks recommended but not required
 - 10+ years of age masks required.
- Receive the directions of Brock United Methodist Ushers for parking, entry to the building, seating/social distancing, singing, and exiting the building.
- Not entering parts of the building that are marked as temporarily closed.
- Consider staying home and worshipping online if I am in a higher risk category.

We understand that the following conditions are modifications from our normal in-person worship:

- Nursery will not be available, but children of all ages are welcome in worship.
- For health and safety reasons children of all ages need to remain with their family throughout the church service.
- We ask that you refrain from handshakes, hugs, or other personal contact.
- Hand sanitizer will be supplied near the building entry doors.
- High touch areas in the building will be cleaned prior to worship service.
- Restroom access will be limited.
- Please ask for assistance from Ushers if there is a need to move any chairs.
- Dismissal will be by family unit, announced by the Pastor and/or guided by Ushers. Please wait until your family name is announced or an Usher comes to guide you.

Our Covenant

We understand the temporary changes and limitations involved with a return to in-person worship. We believe ourselves appropriate physically to participate in a gathering at this time. We further covenant to abide by these conditions, not merely for ourselves but for the well-being of our brothers and sisters in Christ and to in every way possible keep the spirit of our first General Rule to "do no harm."
